



OUR COLLEGE



i) ORIGIN AND HISTORY

Our old Town or One Town, as it is popularly known, has long been neglected in having educational facilities. There was practically no scope or provision for higher education. Barring one or two High Schools, there was no college. Young boys and girls, after their high school studies, had to tread long distances to pursue their studies in colleges in the two town. Especially the girl students faced many hardships in realising their dreams of higher education.

This urgent need for higher educational facilities strongly compelled some of the philanthropic elite of the business community of this part of the town to put their heads and hands together in working towards the goal.

Kakaraparti Bhavanarayana College is truly a dream come true for many, especially for those who are residing in the old town of Vijayawada. The long cherished dream has been realised through the benevolence of Danaseela, Purapramukha and Vidya-Poshaka Sri Kakaraparti Bhavanarayana Sresti. Business magnets Sri Vusirika Jagan Mohan Rao, Sri Koppuravuri Satyanarayana and a host of others also came forward to start the college. The foundation stone of the college was laid on 6th Nov, 1964 by Sri Kasu Brahmananda Reddy, the then Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh. The college was constructed on a sprawling 9.6 acres of land of the S.K.P.V.V. Hindu High Schools' Committee. It commenced functioning fully ever since June 1965. The college had a humble



beginning with 220 students and a devoted staff of just fifteen under the visionary leadership of the Founder Principal Sri S.Sundaram. The college had taken huge strides in its growth and became one of the premier institutions in Vijayawada, sparing no efforts for the last fifty two years in fulfilling its vision and mission.

The infrastructure of the college is admirable. The administrative block has spacious rooms for the Principal, Vice principal and the Management. Classes for Intermediate and Degree are conducted in 36 well furnished and well maintained classrooms. Every department has its own staff room. All the laboratories are well equipped. The college has a state of the art library worth Rs. 10 lakhs with over 37000 volumes. It has a reading room and also a Digital Library with over 12000 e-books. The college is embellished with expansive playgrounds and an Indoor stadium.

Separate rooms are provided for NCC, NSS and GYMNASIUM. The college is also endowed with an elegantly designed open air theatre, 'Kalaniketan' with an open gallery and a seating capacity of 2500, which is one of the spectacular features of the college.

It is a landmark in the history of K.B.N. College.

vi) ISO CERTIFICATION

This is a certificate given for Quality Management standard which created the scope to provide High Quality and standard in Graduate, Post graduate education and Research for developing the students as progressive, competitive, knowledgeble, adaptable and well deciplined citizens.

vii) AUTONOMOUS STATUS

K.B.N. College is conferred with the Autonomous status from the academic year 2010 - 2011 for a period of six academic years. The Executive Council of Acharya Nagarjuna University has also given concurrence and permission for Autonomy on 11-02-2010 (Proceedings of the Executive Council Dt. 04-03-2010). Our College is affiliated to Krishna University since 2010-11. Extension upto 2021.

a) Aims of the Autonomy:

To make the College a responsible, self-generating and self-sustaining institution.

b) Objectives of Autonomy:

- 1. To reshape the curriculum according to the changing needs of the society.
- 2. To offer various modified courses.
- 3. To provide opportunities for employment
- 4. To promote scientific approach and research orientation among the staff and also the students.
- 5. To enjoy freedom in taking prompt and accurate decisions.
- 6. To promote creativity and responsible thought and action for successful implementation of autonomy.

c) Advantages of Autonomy:

- The year is divided into two semesters. The performance of each student is keenly observed and the student is assessed through out the year.
- 2. Prescribe rules for admission in consonance with the reservation policy of the State Government.
- 3. Determine and prescribe its own courses of study and syllabi.
- 4. Conduct tests and examinations as per schedule.
- Continuous assessment through tests, assignments, seminars, field work besides the examination helps the students develop selfconfidence, better study habits and research skills.
- 6. Establish Language lab, Develop speaking, reading and writing skills of the students.
- 7. Evolve methods of assessment of student work, the conduct of examinations and notification of results.

The statutory bodies like Governing Body, Academic Council, Board of Studies, Finance Committee etc., are formulated in accordance with UGC guidelines to ensure proper management of academic, financial and general and administrative affairs. In addition to the above statutory and non-statutory committees such as Planning and Evaluation Committee, Admission Committee, Library Committee, Student Welfare Committee, Extra-Curricular Activities Committee, Appeals and Grievances Committee, Academic Audit Committee, Sports and Games Committee. Examination Committee are formulated for meaningful decentralisation of power.

viii) ACADEMIC PLAN

With the approval of the Academic Council, the College may formulate an appropriate mechanism to evaluate its academic performance, academic regulations, Instructional and evaluation methods, improvement of standards and relevant procedures.

The common programmes to be adopted are:

- a. Semester pattern of study
- b. Continuous Internal Assessment
- c Student feedback
- d. Self-appraisal by teachers

The academic year is divided into 2 semesters, each consisting of 90 instructional days.

Odd Semester: I,III & V Semester – June to October **Even Semester:** II,IV & VI Semester – November to April

Each semester is a unit by itself. Continuous Internal Assessment ensures regular study, monitors students, performance and enables them to self-evaluate. Continuous Internal Assessment includes two mid semester exams, seminars and weightage for attendance. Semester End Examinations are comprehensive type with external evaluation. Regular and supplementary examinations are held twice a year i.e., in November and April. The respective department will provide the syllabi and the model question papers to the students. The pass percentage is fixed as 35% in Semester End Examinations and 40% in case of C.B.C. System.

ix) ATTENDANCE MONITORING CELL

Our college lays highest emphasis on attendance and has established a seperate cell for monitoring the same of every individual student. If a student is found to be absent for the day, the matter would be informed by the convenor of the cell to the concerned parent/Guardian on the very same day by making call to the number provided to us at the time of admission. It is the responsibility of the Parent/Guardian to furnish the current or changed phone number and ensure that information about their respective student is reaching properly to them. They can also make a call to the below mentioned number and enquire about their ward's percentage of attendance anytime they wish for from the convenor between 11 A.M to 5 P.M on all working days. ACADEMIC GUIDELINES

i) ATTENDANCE

- 1.1 Attendance will be calculated in terms of percentage while awarding marks.
- 1.2 Minimum attendance required by a student to take semester end examinations (SEE):
 - i) Theory: 75 percent
- ii) Practicals: 90 percent
- 1.3 Every student has to have at least 75% attendance. If the attendance is between 60% 75% the prescribed condonation fee should be paid in order to write the examinations
- 1.4 If a student participates in Inter-Collegiate or Inter-University, State or National-level tournaments / Athletics / N.C.C. / N.S.S., the actual number of days (excluding Sundays and holidays), shall be added to his / her class attendance, subject to a maximum of 20 days in a semester or 30 days in a year. Prior permission should be taken from the Principal of the College to participate in the above events. The list of participants in the above said events must be submitted by the incharges of the concerned Departments.
- 1.5 If a student is absent even for one period either in the morning session or evening session, he/she will lose half a day's attendance.
- 1.6 A student should apply for leave whenever he / she is absent to college. The sanction of leave is at the discretion of the Principal, whenever the respective Heads of the Departments forward the leave application.
- 1.7 A student of the first semester should seek fresh admission in the event of detention or discontinuation. Any student of 2nd to 5th semester who has shortage of attendance shall be required to repeat the semester in the next academic year.

iii) REGISTRATION

Every student can register himself / herself for the Semester-End Examination through an application by paying the prescribed examination fee within the stipulated time. The college reserves the right of permitting a student for Semester-End Examinations on the grounds of discipline, attendance, etc.

iv) EXAMINATIONS

- 1. Question papers for Semester End Examinations are prepared according to the latest syllabi and model question papers approved by the Board of Studies and ratified by the Academic Council.
- 2. Students who repeat a semester will have to take the Semester End Examinations with the syllabi ratified by the Academic Council and corresponding to the model question papers which are in force at that time and also such students have to clear all the newly added subjects of their previous semester and duly signing an undertaking letter to that effect.

- 3. **Grace Period:** A student who is not able to complete his/her degree studies within 3 years is given a maximum period of 6 years from the date of Admission to appear for his/her Supplementary examinations to complete the degree course.
- 4. All candidates have to answer the question papers in the medium as specified in their applications for admission into the course. No change of medium will be permitted thereafter.

For the students who are admitted from 2017-18:

- ★ The examination system is classified into two parts i.e., Continuous Internal Assessment 25% (CIA) and Semester-End Examination-75% (SEE). Student should get 40% in order to get through the examination during the academic year 2017-18.
- ★ Online Mid-II(internal) examination will be conducted for all subjects of all groups to the students who are admitted from the academic year 2017-18.
- ★ Online examination will be conducted for 30 marks and with a duration of 30 minutes for each subject.

EVALUATION:

The college follows evaluation system based on Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) and Semester-End Examination(SEE). All the students have to pay the prescribed fee for both theory as well as practical examinations. No student will be allowed to take examinations without the payment of fee.

Student will not be promoted to next semester, if they do not pay current semester examination fee.

THEORY:

The 100 / 50 marks allotted for each theory paper in a semester. For 100 marks paper marks are distributed as per 25:75 (CIA:SEE), **for 50 marks paper no CIA only SEE.**

CIA – the student who failed/absent for CIA will appear for **remid exam.**They have to approach the respective lecturers for appearing the remid examination.

Note: There is no Re-mid for online Internal Examination.

MID TESTS:

Each mid test is held approximately after 40 or 45 days of instruction.

The Mid-1 Written test will be conducted for 30 marks and for 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ hour duration. Two tests will be conducted per day.

The Mid-2 Online test will be conducted for 30 minutes as per the schedule bulletin at the time of examination.

Remid Test (supplementary CIA exam):

Re-mid test will be conducted at the end of each semester in the entire syllabus, only to those students who had failed in CIA i.e., for those who do not obtain 10 out of 25 marks. They will be given permission only after paying the necessary Re-mid test fee.

EVALUATION:

The college follows evaluation system based on Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) and Semester-End Examination (SEE). All the students have to pay the prescribed fee for both theory as well as practical examinations. No student will be allowed to take examinations without the payment of fee. Students will not be promoted to next semester if they did not pay present semester examination fee and submit the filled in application to the office of controller of Examination.

THEORY:

The 100 marks allotted for each theory paper in a semester are distributed as per 25:75 secured in CIA and SEE respectively.

vi) PRACTICALS

Practical examinations are held at the end of each semester. No supplementary examination will be conducted. Students will be divided into batches for practical examinations. Each batch has to take the examination on the specified dates as per the schedule. Out of 50 marks 25 is the pass mark (50%).

The student should have at least 90 percent attendance in laboratory work during the sem. Every student should submit a duly certified record by their respective HoD, at the time of the practical exam. If a student fails to submit the record he/she loses 10 marks out of the 50 marks.

vii) CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM (CBCS)

K.B.N.College (Autonomous) has started implementing choice based credit system for the UG Programmes from the academic year 2015-16

★ Credit: A Course Credit is a unit that gives weightage to the value, level or time requirements of the academic Subject. One credit normally represents 15 to 20 hours of formal lectures or equivalent. Most of the subjects are valued at three credits every semester.

- ★ Credits attempted: The number of attempted credits is the total number of credits that have been registered for and are used to calculate the CGPA. Each degree programme contains a minimum of 130 and maximum of 140 credits.
- ★ Course is divided into the following categories.
 - **★** Core courses
 - ★ Core course practicals
 - ★ Ability Enhancing Compulsory Courses(AECC)
 - **★** Foundation Courses
- ★ Grades and Its Numerical Values: Grades in the realm of education are standardized measurements of varying levels of comprehension within a subject area. Grades can be assigned in the letters (for example O,A,B,C,D and F). Each letter grade has a specific numeric value assigned. Grade will be awarded on the basis of marks secured on a 10 point scale.
- ★ **Grade Point:** The grade point represents student's performance in a subject. To determine grade points, the number of credits for the subject is multiplied by the numerical value of the letter Grade.

DECLARATION OF RESULTS:

All the valued answer scripts are scrutinized at the Controller of Examinations Office before the declaration of results to ensure fairness in evaluation. After deliberations at the Awards Committee meeting, results will be declared.

APPEALS:

CIA Valuation & Rectification: Students who have any grievances about the Mid Test and in the tabulation of CIA marks may be brought to the notice of the Principal and Controller of Examinations respectively

viii) REVALUATION:

A candidate may also apply for revaluation of any paper in any subject within one week of the declaration of results and may obtain photo copies of answer scripts after paying prescribed fee within one week of the declaration of the results.

If the difference of marks in first and second valuation is more than 20% i.e., 15 marks, the answer-script will be sent for a third valuation. The average of any two highest valuations will be considered as the final marks of the candidate.

BETTERMENT: A candidate who passes in all the papers of a semester I to V (both CIA & SEE) is eligible to appear at the immediate succeeding SEE for improvement in any/all papers of the concerned semester by paying the prescribed fee. Betterment marks are compared with the previous marks and higher marks of the two will be considered. **A Successful Candidate in VI Semester is not allowed to Reappear for Betterment.**

REFUND OF FEE:

- i) **Refund of Revaluation fee:** If the student is benifited with 10 marks or more
- ii) Refund of Examination fee: If a failed student passes in Revaluation

COMPUTATION OF CLASS:

Computation of class will be carried out only at the end of VI Semester, when the candidate gets through all the 6 semesters.

A student is eligible for the award of a class only when he/she completes the part-II (Group) subjects within three academic years from the date of admission into the course.

NOTE: Any pass after the stipulated limit will be treated as third class, irrespective of the percentage of marks scored. It will be indicated by an (*) in the cumulative marks statement.

GRADE CARD:

Semester-wise Grade cards will be issued to all the registered candidates as and when they are ready. Students who are on leave on the day of issue of Grade card have to collect them immediately after their return. The authorities concerned are not obliged to give Grade card after 90 days from the date of issue. Consolidated Grade card issued to successful candidates at the end of the course on payment of the prescribed fee.

Students are expected to preserve all their Grade cards for future reference. It may be noted that **no duplicate Grade card will be issued as a routine.** In case of loss or damage, duplicate card will be issued after completing the required legal formalities and paying the prescribed fee.

MALPRACTICE:

The college takes a serious view of the unfair methods in all the theory and practical examinations. Influencing the teaching and non-teaching staff at any time by the candidates for any advantage is also considered as malpractice. Cases of malpractice noticed at any stage are severely punishable.

Cancellation of all the written examinations already taken and to be taken by the candidate during that specified period is the immediate minimum punishment.

If students are caught for malpractice in the annual practical examinations, all the practical examinations of that specified period will be cancelled.

If students are booked for malpractice in the mid semester examination, they will not be permitted to appear for the re-mid examination.

If any student is found guilty of malpractice on more than one occasion during his/her stay in the college, he/she may be prohibited from pursuing further studies. A student of Semester VI found guilty of malpractice on more than one occasion may be debarred from examinations for one year.

In all cases of malpractice, the decision of the committee for Malpractices is final and binding. The committee will take the procedure of the rules and regulations related to malpractice cases which will come into force with the approval of the academic council. All malpractice cases will be decided based on these rules and the recommendations of the malpractices enquiry committee shall be approved by the Principal.

College Admission Procedure: As per the G.O.MS.No.34 Higher Education Department, Dated: 15.10.2020, the college is following Online Admission Process for admission into both Undergraduate and Postgraduate Courses conducted by the Government of Andhra Pradesh.

As per the directions of Online Admission Committee, the College Helpline Centre was established is the college campus to provide assistance to the students in registering on Online Admission Module for Degree Colleges (OAMDC), making web options, issues related to allotment of seats, etc. Student once admitted in a particular programme he is liable for payment of the entire programme fee.

Student Dress Code:

Uniform is compulsory in the campus from Monday to Saturday. Students are not permitted to wear revealing clothes in the campus. The appearance of the students at all times on campus should be neat and tidy with groomed hair. Students have to be in uniform for Guest lectures, Workshops, Industrial visits and Examinations (Internal and External), presentations and any other formal functions.

Students not adhering to the above dress code may write an application to the class teacher with a valid reason, for one day permission only for repeated violations after 3 warnings the parents will be informed regarding the same.

Student Discipline:

Students would wear their identity cards compulsory. Its violation is subject to disciplinary action. Cell phones are strictly prohibited in the college. Eve teasing and ragging are forbidden the college.

Ragging:

Anyone found indulging in ragging in any form within or outside the campus, shall be instantly expelled from the KBN College Campus.

- ★ Anti-Ragging Cell has been constituted and all Anti ragging measures have been taken as per UGC norms.
- ★ It is against the discipline of the college to sit or stand as a group / individual or loitering in the campus during the college working hours.

Attendance:

- ★ Attendance will be calculated in terms of percentage while awarding marks. Minimum attendance required by a student to take semester end examinations.
- ★ Theory-75%; Practical-90% At least 60% attendance in theory and 80% attendance in practical is required by a student to pay the condonation for shortage of attendance.

ix) MENTORING SYSTEM (WARD COUNSELING)

Every Staff member would be in-charge of 25 students for mentoring the academic performance and discipline. Student profile book is maintained in the college, which consists of all the information pertaining to the student concerned. Each mentor will officially interact with the student twice a semester. Besides this, the student is encouraged to meet the lecturer concerned by fixing an appointment with him/her for his/her allround development.

x) IDENTITY CARD

Every student will be provided with an identity card which he/she must keep as long as he/she is a student of this college. Whenever he/she approaches the Office/ Departments on academic or administrative matters, he/she must produce his/her identity card. No request will be entertained without the production of the identity card. Along with the hall-ticket, the identity card should also be brought for taking any examination, theory or practical ID Card should always be worn around the neck in the college.

PROCEDURE FOR OBTAINING CERTIFICATES:

1. TRANSFER CERTIFICATE:

- ★ After the completion of the Degree, the TC Application form could be obtained from the Office.
- ★ The Form has to be filled up and 'NO DUES' signatures are to be obtained from the In-charges of the Library, Controller of Exams, College Office, Departments and Labs
- ★ Attach a Photocopy of X Class or Inter T.C
- ★ The Application Form with the above attachments has to be submitted to the College Office.
- 2. MIGRATION CERTIFICATE: Issued to only those who got admission into other courses offered by Universities other than Krishna University after paying the prescribed fee.
- **3. COURSE CERTIFICATE (C C):** A Receipt for Rs.10/- has to be taken from the college cash counter. By producing the Receipt and the ID card, the Study Certificate could be collected from the college office.

4. CONSOLIDATED GRADE CARD:

- ★ At the end of the course CONSOLIDATED GRADE CARD is issued to the successful candidates after paying the prescribed fee.
- ★ Produce the ID card along with the Receipt at the Controller of Examinations to get the Consolidated GRADE CARD.

5. PROVISIONAL CERTIFICATE (PC):

- ★ Provisional certificates are issued to successful candidates on request after the completion of the course and on payment of the required fee.
- \star A Receipt for Rs. 150/- has to be taken from the College cash counter.
- ★ Produce the ID card or Hall ticket along with the Receipt, at the Controller of Exams office to get the **PROVISIONAL CERTIFICATE**.

xiv) RULES & REGULATIONS OF THE COLLEGE LIBRARY

WORKING HOURS OF THE LIBRARY:

- ★ The library and reading room remain open from 7.30 am to 8.00 pm
- ★ Internet facility from 9.00am and to 6.00 pm
- ★ Repographic facility from 9.00 am to 6.00 pm
- ★ Issue of new borrower cards 10.00 am to 10.30 am
- ★ Issue of Books and return of books 10 am to 10.30 am; 1.10 pm to 1.40 pm; 3.10 pm to 3.30 pm; 6.10 pm to 6.30 pm

MEMBERSHIP CONDITIONS TO BORROW LIBRARY BOOKS:

Every student may get his/her library card on showing his/her ID card and college fees receipt at the library counter. The student should not transfer his/her library card to others. The student should show his borrower card on demand.

Every student may borrow two books at a time from the library and may keep it with him/her for two weeks. He /She should not give his/her

books to others. He/She should not spoil the books by drawing the lines. When the student borrows the books from the library he/she should check whether the book is in good condition or not. If the book is damaged or spoiled the student will be held responsible. When a student returns the library books he/she is expected to see that the return of the books is recorded in his/her library card. Reference books, rare books and magazines will not be issued home.

CODE OF CONDUCT:

The moment a student enters the library he/she should put his/her signature in the visitor's register. Students have to maintain silence in the library and in the Reading Room.

Students should not cause any sort of damage to the library property and equipment. If any student causes any damage to the library property and equipment he/she shall pay proper compensation for it. If any student behaves contrary to the rules and regulations of the library, he/she will lose his/her right to enter the library, he/she cannot get any facility from the library.

The rules and regulations which are now in force may be changed or new rules may be framed without any prior notice to the students. The library committee is empowered to do so.

IF THE BORROWER CARD IS LOST:

When a student loses his/her borrower card he/she should inform the librarian about the loss. If books have been borrowed by that time, the students who have lost the card will be held responsible for the borrowed books.

The student may get a duplicate borrower card with the librarian's permission and by paying Rs.5/-.

RENEWAL OF BOOKS AND CANCELLATION OF BORROWED BOOKS:

Books which are not in demand and books which are not registered may be borrowed by the student twice by extending the due date for the return of the books.

The Librarian is empowered to get the books returned to the library by cancelling the borrowing of the books without stating any reasons.

DUES AND FINES:

Books should be returned on or before the date mentioned on the borrower card. If the library books are not returned on or before the due date, fine will be levied. The borrower has to pay Rs. 1/- per book per day after the due date. The fine amount should be paid in the cash counter of the college and submit the receipt in the library.

If the due date is in Holidays, the student has to return the book on the first working day after the holiday.

Even though the student does not attend his/her regular classes, he/she should return the library books on or before the due date.

PAYMENT OF COMPENSATION FOR LOST OR DAMAGED BOOKS:

If the student causes any damage to the library property and equipment he/she should pay the compensation amount fixed by the librarian immediately.

If any student loses a library book he/she should submit a new book to the library.

NO DUES CERTIFICATE:

Students who want to appear for Public Examinations and who want to get their hall tickets should get no dues certificates from the librarian and submit them in the college office.



SCHOLARSHIPS

Students will receive all the government scholarships as per their eligibility like welfare scholarships, EBC scholarships etc. In addition to this, our college management has also instituted several medals and prizes for meritorious students in various subjects.

SCHOLARSHIPS AND EDUCATIONAL CONCESSIONS

The following Scholarships and educational concessions may be sanctioned at the discretion of the authorities concerned.

- 1. **District Welfare Fund Scholarships:** The scholarships are open to pupils of promise of Intermediate and Degree classes whose pecuniary status certified by the Principal prevents them from pursuing their studies without financial assistance. The scholarships are open to all irrespective of the community to which the pupils belong.
- 2. Government of India Scholarships to students from Non-Hindi speaking states for post Matriculation Studies in Hindi:

A student of Intermediate having Hindi as the subject under Part II can apply for the scholarship if he secures 60% in Hindi and also in the aggregate in S.S.C. or equivalent examination.

A degree student having Hindi as the subject under Part – I can apply for scholarship it he secures 60% in Hindi and also aggregate in the Intermediate or an equivalent examination.

3. Social Welfare Department Scholarships: These scholarships are available to scheduled castes, scheduled tribes and all listed backward students, the annual income of whose parents does not exceed Rs. 33,500/- per annum in case of B.C. and Rs. 50,920/- per year in case of S.C & S.T., Applications have to submitted in the prescribed form during the first term.

Note: As per the circular R.C. No. 13603 / 77 Dt: 4-8-77 of the Director of tribal Welfare, A.P. Scholarships should be sanctioned to the students belonging to S.C., S.T. and L.B.C.capped students will be sanctioned by the Director of Higher Education, Andhra Pradesh. Such students should apply in the form prescribed with all the necessary certificates required. The scholarship shall be disbursed to the students only if 75 percent attendance is there and may recover the amount already disbursed if 75 percent attendance criterion has not been fulfilled.

- **4. National Merit Scholarship Scheme:** These awards will be sanctioned by the Director of Higher Education, Andhra Pradesh to the students who secured good marks in S.S.C. examination. Students need not apply for these awards. The scholarships, once awarded under this scheme will be renewed every year till the completion of their final examination provided they secure 50 percent of marks at each University Examination.
- **5.** Education Concessions to the Children of Servicemen & Ex-**Servicemen:** These concessions are sanctioned by the Secretary from the Andhra Pradesh Post war Service Reconstruction fund to the Intermediate students only. Applications should be submitted in the prescribed forms only.

6. Scholarship for the blind, deaf and orthopedically challenged:

Scholarships will be sanctioned by the Director of Higher Education, Andhra Pradesh, Eligible students should apply in the prescribed form with all the necessary certificates required.

- 7. Scholarship for orphans and the destitute: The orphans and destitutes under this scheme shall be awarded scholarships on the basis of merit-cumpoverty of the students. They need not be inmates of an orphanage for the purpose of awarding these scholarships. Candidates who are studying in the first year course are eligible to apply and those who are in the middle of the course are not eligible.
- **8. General Merit Scholarships :** (Applicable to students studying in Andhra Region only)
 - A) Parental income from all sources should not exceed rupees Rs. 6000/- P.A. Income Certificate should be obtained from Revenue authorities not below the rank of Tahasildar and M.R.O. In the case of salaried people the salary certificate must be issued by the employer only. The original Income Certificate must be enclosed with the application form.
 - B) Students who have secured less than 55% marks aggregate in the previous examination are not eligible.
 - C) Compartmental pass and instant pass candidates are not eligible.
 - D) Photocopy of marks memo duly attested by the concerned college Principal must be enclosed with the application form.

9. Riyathi Scholarships:

(Applicable to students studying in Telangana Region only)

- A) Parental income from all sources should not exceed Rs. 6000/-P.A. Income Certificate should be obtained from Revenue authorities not below the rank of Tahasildar and M.R.O. In the case of salaried people the salary certificate must be issued by the employer only. The original Income Certificate is a must.
- B) Students who have secured less than 55% marks aggr egate in the previous examination are not eligible.
- C) Compartmental pass and instant pass candidates are not eligible.
- D) Photocopy of marks memo duly attested by the concerned college Principal must be enclosed with the application form.

10. Scholarships to the children of deceased Govt. Servants:

- A) There is no income limit.
- B) A death certificate duly certified by the last employer of the deceased Govt. Servant, who died while in service is to be enclosed along with the application form.
- C) A Bonafide Certificate in original obtained from the Institution, where the candidate is presently pursuing his studies must be enclosed with the application form.

11. Educational concessions to children and grand children of Political Sufferers:

- A) Parental income from all sources should not exceed Rs.6000/- P.A. Income Certificate should be obtained from Revenue authorities not below the rank of Tahasildar and M.R.O. In the case of salaried people the salary certificate must be issued by the employer only. The original Income Certificate must be issued by the employer only. The original Income Certificate must be enclosed with the application form.
- B) Students' Father/Grandfather (if father is not alive) should have undergone Imprisonment for not less than 6 months or lost part or whole of the property or job. Freedom Fighters certificate duly signed by the General Secretary/President.
- (C) Photocopy of marks memo duly attested by concerned college Principal must be enclosed with the application form.

P.G. ACADEMIC REGULATIONS

Duration:

The PG courses hall be of two years duration, extended over four semesters (Three years and Six semesters for MCA) and adopts choice based credit system (CBCS) and grading system inline with national policies and international practices. The candidates shall be allowed a maximum of five years (Six years in case of MCA) of duration to be eligible for the award of the degree, failing which he/sheshall have to register once again as a fresh candidate.

Medium of instruction and Examination:

The medium of instruction and examination shall be English

Examination Registration:

Students should register for examinations as per the schedule and fee specified by the COE in each semester whether he appears for the exam or not. The registered students who satisfy attendance requirements for the semester only will be promoted to the next semester. The college reserves the right of permitting a student for semester End Examination on the grounds of discipline, attendance etc.,

Evaluation and Semester End Examination:

The performance of the candidate in each semester shall be evaluated course wise, with a maximum of 100 marks for theory / practical, on the basis of the Internal Evaluation for 30 Marks and External Evaluation for 70 Marks.

Internal Evaluation:

The internal Assessment of generic core courses, functional core courses and functional specializations, advanced functional specializations courses shall before 30marks each. It shall be based on Two Mid Examinations - written exam (subjective - preferably first mid and online exam objective type - second mid) for 20 marks each (taking best for awarding the Internal Marks for Mid Examination) and Assignments for 05 marks and Attendance for 05marks in respective subjects.

Attendance Requirement:

Each semester of the course shall be treated as a separate unit for calculation of the attendance. A candidate shall be considered to have satisfied the attendance requirement if he/ shehave attended not less than **75% of the classes in each semester** (Theory & Practical) actually conducted upto the end of the semester.

Condonation of shortage of attendance upto 10% (i.e.65% and above and below 75%) may begiven by the College Academic Committee consisting of Principal / Director, Headofthe Department and two senior faculty members. Condonation of shortage of attendance shall be granted only on genuine and valid reasons on representation by the candidate with supporting evidence. Shortage of attendance below 65% shall in no case be condoned.

A candidate, who does not satisfy the attendance requirement, mentioned as above, shall not be eligible to appear for the Semester End Examination and shall be required to repeat that semester along with regular students during the subsequent year.

If a candidate, for any reason, discontinues the course after the first/third semester he/she may be permitted to register for the second/fourth semester, after one year with the immediate subsequent batch, subject to the condition that he/she shall complete the class work including the project/internship within maximumstipulated period of fiveyears from the date of commencement of the course.

The Principal / Director / HODs of respective departments shall display regularly, the list of such candidates who falls hort of attendance, on the notice boards.

The list of the candidates falling short of attendance shall be sent to the COE before the commencement of Semester end examination. The attendance marks in each subject will be awarded as per the below norms

Short & Long Industrial Study Visits:

The candidate shall make one compulsory short visit to different industrial establishments / corporate offices in the neighbouring towns / cities in the first year and one long visit to different industrial establishments / corporate offices in cities in the second year. All the candidates are required to submit the tour diaries and reports at the time of viva examinations.

Award of Degree and Class:

A candidate shall be eligible for the award of degree if he/she secures the minimum academic requirements in a subject (i.e.securing a minimum of 50% ofmarksin internal examination, 40% marks in theEnd Examination and a minimum aggregate of 50% of thetotalmarksintheEnd Semester Examination and Internal Evaluation taken together). Not with standing anything contained in the above regulations in the case of Project Report / Dissertation and Viva-Voce, a candidate shall obtain not less than 50% of marks to be declared to havepassed in the examination.

Classes shall be awarded to the candidates who have passed in all subjects at each semester on the aggregate marks obtained by the matthe respective semester.

A candidate who secures 70% and above marks in aggregate shall be declared to have passed in first class with distinction.

A candidate who secures 60% or more marks butless than 70% in aggregate shall be declared to have passed in first class.

Candidate who secures 50% or more marks butless than 60% inaggregate shall be declared to have passed in second class.

Classes shall be awarded at the degree level to the candidates who have completed the Course based on theaggregate of all four semesters taken together.

Ranks:

The number of ranks declared at degree level shall be 2. The ranks shall be declared on the basis of the CGPA / aggregate marks of all the four semesters taken together, provided the candidate has passed in all these four semesters in first attempt only (considering marks after revaluation at each semester).

Award of Class:

First class with distinction / First class / Second class is awarded to a candidate as per the above classification provided that he/she completes the course within three years of joining the two year Course or four years in case of three year course.

Only First class / Second class is awarded to a candidate as per the above classification provided that he/she completes the course within four years of joining the two year Course and five years in case of thee year course.

Only Second class is awarded to a candidate irrespective of the percentage he obtained, if he/she completes the course within five years of joining the two year course or six years in case of three year course...

Relaxation in attendance and grace marks will be considered in case of NSS / Sports students as per the norms of the college.

Revaluation:

If students are not satisfied with the marks they scored, they can apply for revaluation as per schedule and fee prescribed by the COE. If the difference between the marks awarded and revaluation marks is not more than 20 per cent of the maximum marks, the marks awarded to the candidate shall be the best of two evaluations. If the difference between the marks awarded and revaluation marks is more than 20 per cent, the script shall be evaluated by a third examiner and the marks awarded to the candidate shall be the average of best two valuations.

Refund of Revaluation Fee:

If the student is benefited with 10 marks or more in revaluation or if a failed student passes in revaluation the revaluation fee paid by the candidate will be refunded.

Photo Copy of answer script:

A Candidate may obtain photo copies of answer scripts after paying prescribed fee within the schedule specified by the COE.

Grading System:

The course will be evaluated and the students will be graded on ten point scale with seven lettergrades i.e., **O**, **A**, **B**, **C**, **D**, **E**, and **F**.
