Progress Report

The present project entitled "Comparative study on Impact of stress on job deliverables and stress management abilities in secondary schools and college teachers," is aimed to be implemented in secondary schools and colleges in the Krishna District of Andhra Pradesh. The objectives of the study are:-

- I. To determine factors that cause stress among teachers in secondary and higher education sector.
- II. To explore whether these factors have positive or negative impact on job performance.
- III. To study and compare stress management abilities among teachers working in secondary and higher education sector.
- IV. To study socio-psychological dynamics and impact of stress and stressors on teaching abilities on secondary and higher education teachers.
- V. To derive significance of teacher training course in enhancing the stress management abilities among teachers
- VI. To assess the role of management in creating stress free environment in educational institutions.

In this connection primary data was collected from different Government and private secondary schools and colleges that are located in Krishna district using the survey method. The survey was conducted by using a closed ended questionnaire containing questions that were framed specifically for the purpose. The questionnaire was divided into three categories

- a. Personality characteristics
- b. Inter-personal relations and
- c. System factors

Responses lectures from the teachers working in secondary schools, lecturers workings in colleges were obtained during the lunch break or during leisure.

This project entitled "Comparative study on impact of stress on job deliverables and stress management abilities in secondary school and college teachers helps to identity various causes of stress and assessing the stress management ability of teachers teaching at secondary and college levels. Data analysis was completed and submitted to Project Appraisal Committee for review.

This project helped me obtaining research experience. I am thankful to the UGC authorities for accepting the project and for financial support. Final technical report along with statistical analysis will be submitted within three months of the completion of the project. I herewith enclose the raw tables.
