

Analysis of Student Feedback - 2017-18

A structured feedback format is designed on curriculum, taking into consideration the latest developments in the subjects, industry requirements and the needs of the society. The IQAC took a feedback from various stake holders like students, parents, alumni and teachers to assess the quality of curriculum.

The analysis of the student's feedback for the year 2017-18

- 1. Whether the course content met with your expectations.
 - 70% of the students expressed that course content is excellent.
 - 20% of the respondents felt that the course content was very good.
 - Remaining 10% of the respondents felt that the depth of the course content was satisfactory.
- 2. Whether the course is relevant to the current job market needs
 - 80% of the students of BCA, BBA, B.Com logistics and others B.Sc. courses with computer applications found that the course content is fully relevant to the current job market needs as skill based courses are introduced in the cluster system from 2017-18.
 - 70% of non-computer course students like CBZ & MPC & B.Com general expressed their satisfaction as they are also selected for different software companies and Medical transcriptional and coding companies like Transdyne, ILM learning solutions etc.
- **3.** How do you rate the sequence of the courses that you have studied are in sequence to what you have studied in the previous semester?
 - The sequence of courses is given first grade by 85% of the students.
 - 15% of the respondents found the sequence of the course from the previous semester is good.
- **4.** How do you rate the relevance of the units in syllabus relevant to the course?
 - 70% of the respondents found the sequence of units is excellent.
 - 20% of the respondents found the sequences of units was most suitable
 - 5% found the sequence of units in the syllabus followed on par is suitable.
- **5.** How do you rate the relevance of the Text books and Reference books by their recognition to the courses?
 - The rate of relevance of Textbooks and reference books are also given excellent grade by 90% of students.
 - 10% of the respondents gave good grade.

 - 20% of the students felt that the load of syllabus is slightly more.
 - 80% of students felt the load of syllabus is accurate.
- 7. Rate the courses in terms of extra learning or self-learning considering the design of the courses.
 - 75% of the students have given 'A' grade to the courses in terms of extra learning.
 - 15% of the respondents have given 'B' grade to the courses in terms of extra learning.
 - 10% of the respondents have given moderate opinion.
- **8.** How do you rate the evaluation scheme designed for each of the course?
 - The respondents expressed 100% satisfaction to the evaluation scheme designed for each course.
- **9.** How do you rate the percentage of courses having LAB components?
 - 90% of the students expressed that labs are having good infrastructure and advanced equipments. The method of demonstration by the faculty has gained 100% satisfaction.

- 10% of the respondents felt for more improvement of labs.
- **10.** How do you rate the experiments in relation to the real life Application?
 - 90% of the respondents found the lab experiments and field projects are useful in real life applications. Students expressed their confidence to start self-employment schemes and become an entrepreneur.
 - 10% of the students felt that the field projects are good.

- Faculty are also advised to reduce the load of curriculum if possible as suggested by students.
- Faculty are advised to conduct more Hands on Training Programs to students.



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

- All the lecturers are advised to plan for Internship programs & industry academia programs.





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

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




