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### Report

The Department of English organized a Guest Lecture on "Technical English for Professional Aspirants" by KBN Alumni on 1<sup>st</sup> February, 2020 at 2.00 pm. Dr. B. Neelambaram, Asst. Prof., Dept. of English, VR Siddhartha Engineering College, Kanuru was the Resource Person. Ms. S. Santha Kumari, Lecturer, Dept. of English invited the Guest on to the dais and Ms. S. Hema Sri Vani, II B.Sc. (DS) introduced the Resource Person.

Dr. Neelambaram began his Lecture on Technical English, with the origins of English Language and its history, evolution and the influences of other European languages on English.
