5. Evidence of Success: Students who participated in various competitions have always bagged either first or second prizes.

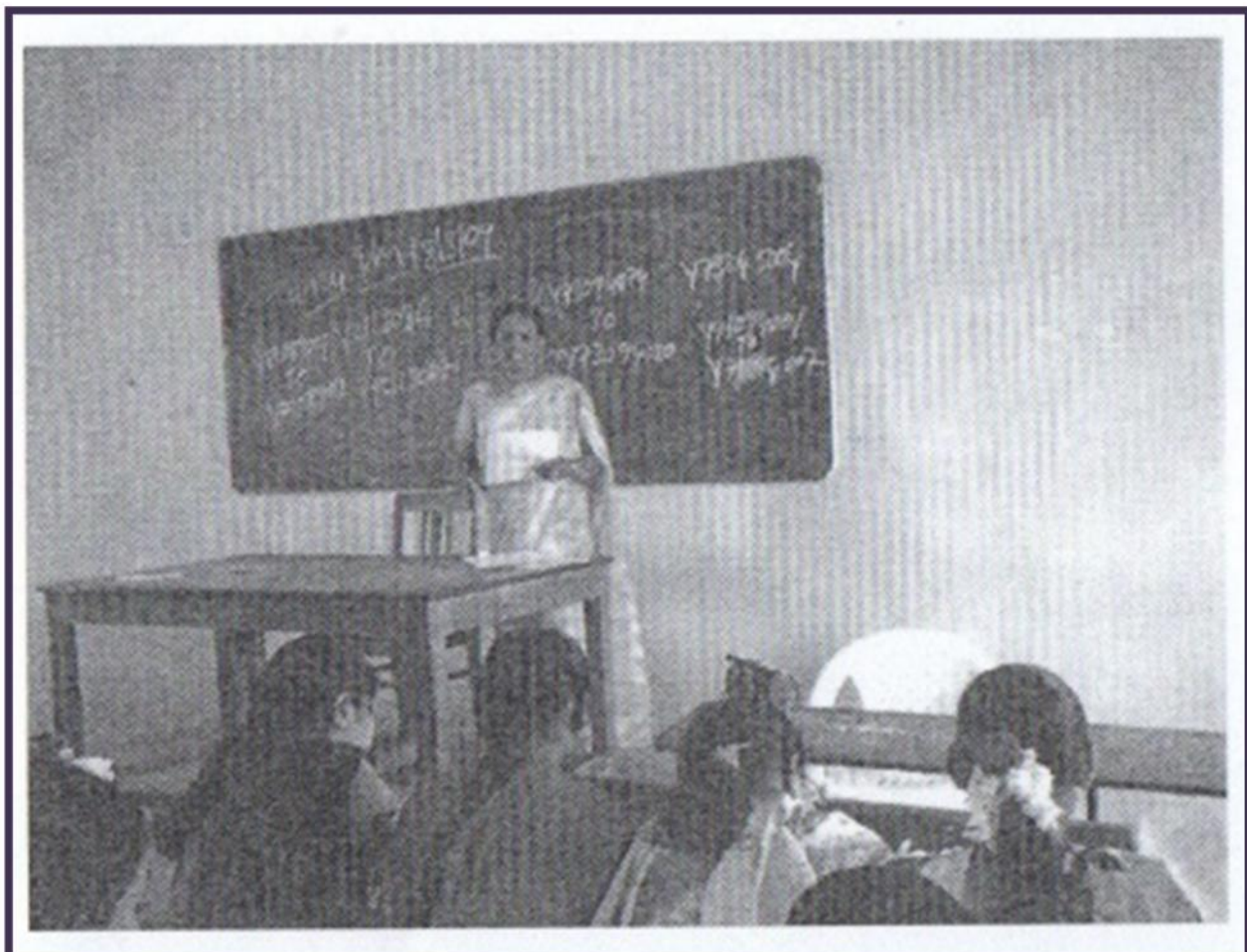
6. Problems Encountered:
