TITLE OF THE PRACTICE

Training in spoken Hindi to students who opted Telugu as second language.

Objective of the course

- To enable students to use Hindi fluently as their mother tongue.
- This course will enhance their academic profile.
- To make students familiar with basic knowledge of Hindi language.
- To impart reading and writing skills in Hindi.
- To develop their confidence.
- To improve and enhance vocabulary and usage of Hindi.

THE CONTEXT

Hindi is our National language which is widely spoken and understood by the people of all regions in India. India is a multilingual country. Hindi and English are languages widely spoken over the country. Knowledge of Hindi language will enable students to enhance their skills improve their performance and to relocate to any place in India to explore employment opportunities. Hindi is not only popular language known all over India but also understood and spoken in other parts of the world too. There are thousands of Indians in various countries of the world USA, UAE, UK, France where Hindi is spoken. It is a language which unites the people of India. It is a source of unity in a country of people who speak different languages.

Practice:

When we decided to provide spoken Hindi training to students who chose Telugu as their second language, we came up with an idea for the consent of our principle. Our proposition was accepted by him. We identified all Telugu second language students and discussed the value of Hindi with them, as well as encouraging them to learn Hindi. On Fridays and Saturdays from 6:20p.m to 7:20 p.m.

The following content was taught

- 1. Vowels, Consonants- Maathra-joining letters vocabulary.
- 2. Days of weeks-vegetables, flowers, part of body, Hindi numbers 1-100, fruits-animals, birds, translations
- 3. Self-introduction. Hindi daily usage or Hindi in daily conversations.

These students receive training from the department's faculty members. They are taught the fundamental sounds and maathraye in Hindi, as well as word

creation and numerous converstions for daily use and according to the learners' needs. Business conversations in Hindi, as well as letter writing and compositional skills, are taught to help students enhance their writing abilities. The goal of this course is to teach pupils how to speak Hindi fluently.

SUCCESS OF EVIDENCE:

This greatest practice provides training to 40 students from diverse courses each year. Twenty-five of them pursued higher education in other states such as Uttar Pradesh, Delhi, and others. Around ten of them have gone on to pursue marking employment in other states as a result of this training. Ten students pursued journalism as a career path and began working as freelance journalists and news reporters.

PROBLEM ENCOUNTED:

Due to the timing, students were first hesitant to attend the classes. However, as time passed, their interest and excitement drew them back to class on a regular basis.
