

Session In-Charge: Smt. L. Sravani, Asst. Prof. in MCA



Topic: Google Forms Vs. Microsoft Forms

Dr. B. Surendraath Reddy, Institutional NAAC Core Member & Assistant Professor, School of Mathematical Sciences, S.R.T.M. University, Nanded was the resource person on the 2nd Day i.e. 11th June, 2020 first Session. The topic of his presentation was Google Forms Vs. Microsoft Forms. He started with sharing his personal opinion on the advantages and disadvantages of Google Forms and Microsoft forms. He did not spoke much on Microsoft forms but suggested the participants to go through the videos, prepared by him and uploaded in YouTube for a better understanding on Google Forms. He explained the advantages and disadvantages of Google Forms and Microsoft Forms from his observations.

Google Forms are well known and most popular among other forms. He said varieties of questions are available in Google forms and there are plenty of add-ons for more powerful forms.

As a disadvantage, there is no Google form available to support Mathematics and there is no straight forward way to support or download the analysis. He had elaborated practically on the use of Microsoft forms which is a new area to many of the teachers.


Microsoft forms though young to Google Forms, have variety of themes to make forms look beautiful. He said Microsoft forms besides being useful for other platforms it is useful for mathematics teacher.

He had also given a clear idea on ICT tools such as Google Forms, Google Form Quiz, Google classroom, Edmodo, Testmoz, Certify'em and Google forms for administration. Finally he affirmed that though Microsoft forms have better advantages than Google forms, still Google forms are useful in many ways.


At the end of the session he received good number of questions from the participants which were addressed patiently by the speaker. All the participants congratulated the speakers for the vibrancy and clarity in his information.

The session titled, "Google Classroom as a Learning Management System (LMS)" has started at 11.40 A.M. The speaker of the session is Dr. Rupali Jain.


The speaker of the session revealed the core existence of Google classroom, i.e, teaching for a class with technical support, teaching with no paper support and to facilitate the students. A Google Classroom is a platform used in teaching and learning digitally under single roof. The resource person has created awareness on creating the Google classroom, the approach of adding students/participants into the classroom, the way of assigning tasks to the members, checking the status of participants who viewed the information shared. Finally, grading the tasks.

The speaker has presented live screen demo of a Google classroom, and the various options available. Such as how to give announcement to the students, how to share the student ideas through Google classroom, how to send messages privately while grading the marks to an assignment and the options available to conduct a quiz programme, a question paper with multiple choice questions and the options available to grade the assigned tasks.


The session was ended by clarifying the questions asked by the participants and she received a good appreciation from the participants.

Session In-Charge: Ms. G. Geetha Pavani, Lecturer in Computers


In this session, he explained the importance of recording lectures through online during this COVID period and also the importance of giving live lectures through YouTube live stream. He mentioned the following in his speech.


- We use different platforms to deliver online lecture we can develop through LMS
- Platforms for delivering online lecture includes ZOOM, WebEx, Google meet.
- OBS (open broad caster software) is used for online classes which is absolutely free and open source.
- We don't need any internet connection for recording and for uploading. we require the connection.
- We can go live streaming in YouTube using OBS.
- While designing the online lectures we have to observe that each slide should contain limited and exact content.
- To grab the audience attention, restrict the video to 50 minutes.
- Some of the tools which are used for effective online lecture includes
 Virtual Board, Pentablet, Epic Pen, Xournal ++
- Xournal++ is an hand writing tool which is open source and mainly used for mathematical purposes.

Topic: LMS-EDMODO


Session In-Charge: Mr. VTR Pawan Kumar, Asst. Prof. in MCA

- Edmodo is an easy way to get your students connected, so they can safely collaborate, get and stay organized, and access assignments, grades, and school...
- Edmodo login contains 3 types Teacher, student, and parents
- Edmodo login can be done through Gmail also.
- Creating a class in Edmodo is same as in Google class room.
- We can create assignments, quiz in Edmodo.
- To invite the participant's we can share the class code
- Using Edmodo we can create Unique profile URl.
- We can assign the grade points for the assignment's submitted by the students and we upload pdf files.
- We can view the overall progress of a particular student based on the assignments, quiz submission.
- We can send messages, share class materials, and make learning accessible anywhere. Save yourself time by bringing all your classroom tools together.
- Edmodo gives teachers the tools to share lessons, keep parents updated, and build a vibrant classroom community.



<u>Topic:</u> Psychological Issues among Students, Faculty and Parents due to Pandemic

<u>Session In-Charge:</u> Ms. R. Jayamma, Asst. Prof. in M.Sc. (CS) & Mr. S. Vasu, Lecturer in Computers

The speaker of the session has discussed about the effect of Covid-19 on education sector, vedic psychology for integrated learning, various challenges of online teaching and learning. The speaker first explained about Corona virus and the symptoms the sufferer undergoes. Care to be taken in respect of infants, disease sufferers and the importance of social distancing. He revealed the possibilities to overcome this pandemic situation, vaccine discovery, partial lockdown, strict lockdown. At this situation, students of graduation and other higher studies have to plan themselves and be ready for the family environment, industry, society, country.

The speaker has shown few PPTs to the participants in live, he revealed the importance of physical presence of student in the campus, the student can watch and observe different employees working in the campus, right from watchman to principal, can understand the heritage of institution, learn togetherness, having fun, involvement in sports, cultural events, learn adjustments, sacrifices, life lessons from the visitors.

He spoke about inner learning, its components like patience, self-denial, self-mastery yoga, concentration and outer leaning, its components like Vedas, vedangas, philosophy, debating, laws, itihasas, dharma sutras. He revealed the

challenges of online learning like students mastering inner learning, learning tolerance, discover the deeper layers of personality.

The speaker revealed the behaviour of a student like limited interaction and respect among members, no goals, enters into fashionable education, influence of media, and friends, may get a job in MNC and fly abroad, who grow vertically and die horizontally.

The challenges faced by teachers and students in such situations are currently students cannot be taught self-learning, managing attention of students, no proper evaluation system, nothing like live conversation, absence of social learning, severe impact on teachers, student responsibility increases, teachers are effected of online evaluation.

At the end, some of the videos sent by participants to face this pandemic, were played and participants feedback has taken. Sri E.Varaparasad, in his president closing remarks congratulated the team of IQAC for successfully organizing this webinar. Finally, the session ended with a formal vote of thanks by Dr.P. Bharathi devi.


