Report

The inaugural Session of One Day National Workshop on "Benefits and Challenges of Interdisciplinary Research" organised by IQAC, started at 10.00AM in the Vivekananda Seminar Hall on 13.11.2018. Smt. P. Bharati Devi, Head, Department of MCA and member of IQAC invited the guests on to the dais. The chief guest of this workshop is Prof. K. Rama Mohana Rao, Principal, Arts & Commerce, Andhra University, Visakhapatnam. He inaugurated the workshop along with other resource persons, Dr. Venkateswara Podile, Prof. in MBA, Andhra Loyola Institute of Engineering & Technology, Dr. C. Nagaraju, Associate Prof. & Head, Dept. of CSE, Yogi Vemana University, Principal Dr. V. Narayana Rao, Vice-Principals Sri. E. Vara Prasad, Dr. K. Naveen Kumar and Academic Director Sri. P. L. Ramesh by lightening the lamp.

The Presidential address was given by Dr. V. Narayana Rao, Principal of the college. He gave a brief account of the activities of the IQAC and expressed his views on Interdisciplinary research stating that a number of recent surveys that are conducted has established that Inter Disciplinary Research has an essential role in bringing various disciplines together for developing the research capacity as well as the most innovative forms of research in formal teaching. The theme of the workshop was given by Dr. V. Subhashini, IQAC—Co Coordinator, She said that IQAC of KBN College has organized this Workshop to emphasize the current importance of IDR and to bring out an approach to solve such problems through Inter Disciplinary Research.

The chief Guest Prof. K. Rama Mohana Rao was introduced by Sri. J. Panduranga Rao, IQAC member and lecturer in Physics. The Chief Guest in his Key note address appreciated the faculty for choosing this topic for the workshop. He said that interdisciplinary nature of our research is valuable for its immediate benefits and for keeping the doors open to diverse care

He concluded that Scientists are getting together, talking, and sharing ideas and the results are fascinating and this type of approach should be developed among the researchers.

Technical Session I: After a tea-break the first technical session started with the lead lecture of Prof. K.Rama Mohan Rao, Principal, Arts & Commerce, Andhra University. He gave a detailed account on Research Methodology. He covered topics like Requirements for taking up Research, Qualities of Good Research, Problem identification and Approaches of research.

Technical Session II: The lead lecture was given by Prof. P. Venkateswara Rao Andhra Loyola Institute of Engineering & Technology, Vijayawada on Research Journals and Publications of papers. He gave detailed information about the websites of National and International Journals that are UGC listed. He also gave details about Citation index and Hindex, He concluded by giving information about Social Networking sites for researchers.

Technical Session III & IV: After lunch the third technical session started. It was addressed by Associate Professor Dr. C. Nagaraju, Yogi Vemana University, Produttur. The IV technical session was also taken by Dr. C. Nagaraju. In both the sessions he emphasised the importance and development of Interdisciplinary Research and dealt from discovery to application.

He said that scientific activity, with all list technical and economic consequences, is at present passing through a period of particularly rapid development as compared with other human activities. He added that previously the sciences could be classified into six or seven main categories known as disciplines, ranging from mathematics to sociology. But at the beginning of the twentieth century, there has been what might be described as an intradisciplinary dismemberment, each of the main categories splitting up into increasingly specialized fields, each of which rapidly assumed comparable importance to that of the actual disciplines from which it sprang.
