

Details of Competitions

1. Mathematics Quiz

- This competition is for Intermediate and Degree students.
- There should be three students in a group.
- Questions will be asked from general concepts of Mathematics like History of Maths, Mathematician's life histories, Problem solving, Logical questioning.

2. Treasure Hunt

- Intermediate, Degree and B. Ed students can participate in this competition.
- Each team should have a maximum of three students.

3. Drawing

Topic: Mathematics Rules the World

Time: 60 minutes

- Intermediate, Degree and B. Ed students can participate in this.
- This is not a group competition. Only individual can participate in this competition.
- All the necessary equipment for drawing should be brought by the participants of the competition. The college does not provide any equipment.
- The picture should be drawn only on the drawing sheets.

4. Mathematics Greeting Card

- Intermediate, Degree and B. Ed students can participate in this competition.
- This is not a group competition. Only individual can participate in this competition.
- Students should bring the necessary material for making the greeting card. College does not provide any equipment.

5. Mathematics Antyakshari

- Intermediate, Degree and B. Ed students can participate in these competitions.
