#### ITC PSPD UNIT, BHADRACHALAM, TELAGANA

The PG Department of Business Administration organized an industrial study visit to ITC PSPD Ltd, Bhadrachalam on May 5th and 6th, 2023. A total of 97 students participated, accompanied by 3 faculty members. The visit was divided into two days, with permission granted by ITC for 50 students each day.

On May 5th, we departed from the Bus Stand Premises at 6:30 am with 46 students and 3 faculty coordinators. We arrived at ITC Bhadrachalam at 11:00 am. Upon reaching the company, the students were divided into two smaller groups, each consisting of 25 students and one faculty coordinator. The industry coordinator, Asst. HR Reshma from ITC, accompanied the students and took them to the seminar hall for an interactive session with the Assistant HR Manager.

Before the plant visit, the company representatives instructed the students to wear helmets and shoes to enter the plant. Subsequently, they guided the students through the in-house plant, explaining various concepts related to paper production and other activities carried out at the ITC PSPD unit. The company coordinators showcased all the production machinery and other related equipment used in the paper-making process. They also demonstrated the packing units for paper bundles. The first batch of 25 students completed the plant visit, followed by the second batch.
