




7.1.5: Green campus initiatives:







KBN College should demonstrate higher sensitivity and responsibility in implementing green concepts in the campus. In addition to promoting green practices within the institution, the campus sustainability initiatives develop best practices strategies in environmental management. The establishment and maintenance of green campuses are important, but we place the highest priority on educating students and stakeholders on green practices.

The policy starts with information and ends with a plan of action. Consequently, the institution will manage water and waste resources fairly, conserve natural resources, provide eco-friendly supplies, and recommend minimal paper usage. In order to establish and maintain a green campus, the Institute will implement the following practices and adopt awareness and green initiatives beyond the campus as well. This will result in safe environment that is a better place to live, learn and play.

Water Management:

- Always practice and implement rain water recycling and harvest rain water to resolve and manage water scarcity problems in future.
- Protect environment towards climatic changes and conservation of sources for drinking water.
- Regularly inspect tops for draining and repair immediately to avoid loss of patable water.
- Promote effective water management drip pipe lines, recycling of drainage and rain water harvesting.

Waste Management:

- To ensure that waste management is performed in accordance with all waste legislative requirements, including the duty of care, and to plan for future legislative changes and to mitigate their effects.
- To minimise waste generation at source and facilitate repair, reuse and recycling over the disposal of wastes in a cost effective manner.
- To provide clearly defined roles and responsibilities to identify and co-ordinate each activity of the waste management.
- To promote environmental awareness in order to increase and encourage waste minimisation, reuse and recycling.
- To invest into the expansion of recycling apportunities on the College campus and transform waste into value added products.
- To ensure the safe handling and storage of wastes on College campus.
- To provide appropriate training for teacher, resident, staff, students and other stakeholders on waste management issues.
- To promote holistic approach of waste management in the campus.

Renewable Energy:

- Educate the public about renewable energy.
- Encourage the adaptation of solar power equipment and converters.
- Promote the use of power-saving electrical equipment.
- Be mindful of the significance of scientific electrification and the utilization of bulbs and equipment in conserving energy.

Paperless Office:

- Explain the advantages of shifting to paperless work as a means of reducing waste production and promoting environmentally friendly practices.

Green initiatives beyond the campus:




TIPS to save energy:















