OVERVIEW OF THE SESSIONS

Day 1: January 8, 2025

Resource Person: **Mr. Vivek D. Patki, M R PAI Foundation**

Goal Setting & Achieving: A Roadmap to Success

Content:

Mr. Patki emphasized the importance of setting clear, measurable, and achievable goals. He introduced the SMART (Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Relevant, Time-bound) criteria for goal setting, encouraging students to envision their future and design a roadmap to success.

Sharpening Communication Skills
